Myths in a new shape

During one week in October, opera, composition and sound art students from Vilnius, Oslo and Gothenburg cooperated and created a musical drama in a whole new shape

From the common ground text in Ovidius's Pygmalion and the Orpheus myths the students improvised with the text and created music which lead to a brand new tale





Study, rehearsing and public performance of the excerpt of traditional opera work in a new setting, enabling students to cooperate and work together, with the supervision of teachers of study fields in opera, composition, and sound art
