Dialogue and control

The Danish performance contract system represents an agreement and common understanding on mission and goals between:

Society represented by the state and

A professional state institution

It is also the primary control system!

The Danish performance contract system Control works with: Focus on result management

Purpose:

- Transparency in the use of tax payers' money
- Securing alignment between the political priorities and the focus of state institutions
- Coupling of economy and strategy of activities

The Danish performance contract system Definition of result management:

Future (4 year performance contract):

Expected outcome – focus on effects

Expected output – focus on type and quality

Past and now

(Yearly report – verbal and written):

Follow-up on results: outcome and output

The Danish performance contract system Objectives of result management:

Simple and efficient management of state institutions by the ministry

Meaningful and and valuable management for the institutions

Process

Strategical and dialectical dialogue between ministry and institution — based on trust with the institutional leadership

Result:

Definition of mission, vision and targets
Agreement on criteria for fulfilment of mission
Expressed in a performance contract

The Danish performance contract system Mission for music academies:

- 1. Further artistic education
- 2. Artistic and music pedagogical development
- 3. Being a cultural institution

For each mission:

Further artistic education

Artistic and music pedagogical development

Being a cultural institution

we define

Result targets

For each result target we agree upon operational targets.

The operational targets are defined as indicators and key figures

Example from Syddansk Musikkonservatorium:

Mission:

Art- and cultural institution

Result Target:

Strenghtening the collaboration of the musical environment in our region

Operational target (one of more):

Conferences/seminars for the musical environment in 2016 and 2018

Syddansk Musikkonservatorium 2015-18:

7 result targets
supported by
20 operational targets
(indicators and key figures)

The Danish performance contract system Control and follow-up:

Principle: Combining finance and activity

- Quarterly report on expected results
- Yearly written report on achieved results
- Yearly meeting between ministry and institutional leaders— verbal report based on the Yearly report
- Yearly interview with rector and his/her superior

The performance contract is

- An agreement on core and development activities of the institution
- An agreement on the basic key financial and activity figures

The performance contract is NOT

- A legal contract
- but more an extended mutual letter of intent!
