Changes taking place

- * New student admissions system for all levels of education 2015-
 - -> only one place can be accepted, focus on first-timers
- * Secondary vocational education (conservatories) is being reorganized
 - -> curricula, degrees, governance structures
- * New law for universities of applied sciences under construction
 - -> all universities of applied aciences will become joint-stock companies directly financed by the state
- * Universities of Applied Sciences have had to apply for their educational responsibilities
 - -> a lot of debate on how to reorganize and prioritize. Some programmes will end, but so far only Lahti has decided to end the entire music programme

Changes taking place

- * Decreasing funding for universities, more severe cuts in other sectors. Incentives for university fundraising
- * A new forum for discussion; representatives of all institutions with professional education in the field of music (Secondary Vocational Education, Universities of Applied Sciences, University of the Arts), with representatives also from the music schools
 - -> How do we develop the national educational system in the field of music?
- * In coming years a focus on orchestral training
- * University of the Arts Helsinki in its second year of existence
